Group Members: Half the class

Problem Statement: The goal is to sit in a circle and toss the tube to the subject directly left of one. When that is done without falling subjects are to stand and repeat. If completed flawlessly the test becomes to engage with the person directly left to the subject on one's left. The first succeeding group of subjects is rewarded with continuation.

Approach: Proceed to accomplish the above without failing. For the final test we had every second subject rotate 180 degrees in order to minimize inter-projectile collisions.
